**TO: All Chartered Property Casualty Underwriters**

We have moved to our new offices in Huebner Hall at the American Center for Insurance Education in Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania. As we did at 3924 Walnut Street, we share this building with the American College of Life Underwriters, American Society of Chartered Life Underwriters, Insurance Institute of America and the Society of Chartered Property Casualty Underwriters.

Please mark your calendar for June 1 and 2. An impressive dedication celebration has been planned for these dates. Although a formal mailing is being prepared, we want to give you a preview of our plans.

On June 1, from 1 to 5 p.m., there will be tours of the new building. The actual dedication ceremony will be at 3 p.m. with Dr. Gaylord P. Harnwell, President of the University of Pennsylvania as the main speaker. In the evening, there will be an All-Industry banquet at the Sheraton Hotel in Philadelphia.
