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CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION  
of the  
AMERICAN COLLEGE OF LIFE UNDERWRITERS

Know All Men by These Presents That we, the undersigned citizens and residents of the United States of America, desiring to associate ourselves for the purpose of establishing an institution of learning by virtue of the provisions of Sub-Chapter I of Chapter 18 of the incorporation laws of the District of Columbia as provided in a code of laws for the said District enacted by Congress and approved by the President of the United States, do hereby certify and declare as follows:

1st The name and title of this institution shall be known in law as The American College of Life Underwriters.

2nd The number of directors of this institution shall be twelve who shall be for the first year, or until their successors are elected and installed, the following: George D. Alder, Franklin W. Ganse, Frank L. Jones, Hugh D. Hart, Paul F. Clark, John Newton Russell, Ernest J. Clark, Edward S. Brashears, Edward A. Woods, J. Stanley Edwards, Guy MacLaughlin and Charles L. Scott.

3rd The particular branches of literature and science proposed to be taught are: The science of insurance in all its branches; the history and literature of life insurance; the science of business administration and office management; the science of salesmanship; the science of economics and finance; and English literature.

4th The number and designation of professorships to be established are as follows: Professorship of Economics; Professorship of Commercial Law; Professorship of Finance; Professorship of Life Insurance; Professorship of English; Professorship of Business Administration and Office Management; and Professorship of Life Underwriting.

5th The term for which this institution is to exist is perpetual.

6th This institution shall have all the rights and powers granted to such institutions under and by virtue of Sub-Chapter I of Chapter 18 of the incorporation laws of the District of Columbia and shall likewise be subject to all the limitations in such Sub-Chapter contained.

7th The principal office of such corporation is located at 710 - 14th Street, N.W., Washington, D. C., and its resident agent is Edward S. Brashears.
