## "Necrology"

'05 Gr, '31 H. Dr. Solomon S. Huebner, Merion, recognized as the "father of insurance education." Emeritus professor of insurance, he retired after teaching an estimated 75,000 students at Pennsylvania. He developed the first collegiate-level courses in the world in insurance from the economic viewpoint and also wrote the first textbooks on that and on organized commodity and insurance exchange markets. Dr. Huebner was best known for his development of the "human life value" idea which places a dollar value on a man's earnings and indemnifies it for the sake of those who depend on that earning power. In 1931 the University awarded him an honorary doctor of science degree and in 1950 the S. S. Huebner Foundation for Insurance Education was established in his honor. He was one of the first to be selected for the Insurance Hall of Fame when it was instituted in 1957; July 17.
