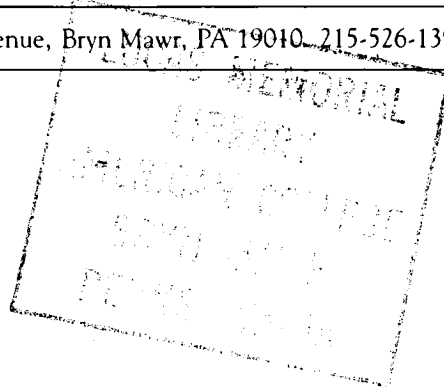

The mission of the Institute is to generate knowledge to enhance quality of life across the life span through developing, applying, and disseminating knowledge about the relationship between financial well-being and general well-being.

The Institute, located on the campus of The American College at Bryn Mawr, is governed by the College's Board of Trustees, its own Board of Overseers and a nationally known Research Advisory Council. It is funded initially through a \$2 million gift.
